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As many of you are aware, over the last few years we've had problems with water entering the steeple and causing damage to the ceiling in the rear of the sanctuary. This spring the property committee engaged local steeple experts to get an idea of what could be done about the problem. We worked with one firm based in Toledo, Ohio Building and Restoration, and another based out of Detroit, Detroit Steeplejack. OBR has done other work on our building in the past. Detroit Steeplejack has several positive reviews.

OBR's inspection revealed sizeable gaps that have developed in the steeple as the wood has degraded through the years. It is their evaluation that these gaps, and not the screened-in louvers, is the way in which water is getting into the building. As a temporary measure, they applied some caulk to minimize further damage. Detroit Steeplejack also inspected the steeple and came to the same conclusion - the wood has degraded over the years and needs to be repaired or replaced.

Another option would be to remove the steeple entirely. Church records and oral history indicate that the building was originally designed without a steeple and stood for at least a decade without it. Decades ago there was a consultant who worked with the synod who advised churches that they should all have both flat rooves and steeples. Several congregations in our synod are in the same position as we are, maintaining a steeple that was added on after the original building was completed.

If you are reading this article online, <u>you can follow this link</u> to a folder that contains bids from OBR and Detroit Steeplejack as well as photos of the steeple in its present condition. The bid from OBR is for the repair and

revitalization of the existing steeple. They estimate that it would need additional work about every five years in order to remain in good condition. There are two bids from Detroit Steeplejack. One is for the repair and revitalization of the steeple. That work is guaranteed for 15 years. The second quote is to remove the steeple entirely. Paper copies of these bids are available from the church office upon request.







Because of the size of this repair, the council has taken two steps:

- 1. Call a congregational meeting, as required by the church constitution, to approve one of these bids.
- 2. Authorize a special appeal to raise the funds necessary for this project. Our 2023 budget does not have the funds necessary to perform this work.

A congregational meeting is scheduled for May 7th following worship. This project will be the sole item on the agenda. If you have any questions about the project I invite you to reach out to me or to Carolyn Gardetto or Chuck Sanscrainte, property committee co-chairs.

Elevator. The bills paid to have the repairs done was a little over \$3,000.

The total YTD loss is largely due to general giving being much lower than expected and investments still not recovering due to slow market growth.
