Perhaps it was during a heartwarming Easter service filled with hope, or the cherished Christmas Eve gathering that brought peace to our souls. Maybe it was a deeply personal moment, like witnessing a family baptism, celebrating a confirmation, or mourning at a loved one's funeral. While we recognize that the building itself isn't magical, it's undeniably a place that many of us hold dear.

This year, our Stewardship Drive is called **"Building Strength Together**." Our intention is twofold. First, we aim to grow stronger as a tightly-knit community of faith, deepening our spiritual bonds and collective commitment. Second, we are dedicated to maintaining and enhancing our physical building to serve as an ever-ready platform for a wide spectrum of ministries.

Last year, when the Monroe High School Madrigal Singers performed the Fellowship Hall became a place where teens who may not fit in anywhere else blended their voices with joy and harmony. And for one amazing week each summer a new cohort of children join the thousands who have gathered

there before to jump, sing, laugh, play, and learn the stories of the faith during Vacation Bible School. Our building is more than wood, brick, and stone - it is a tool for growing in faith and serving our neighbors.

This October and November, we invite you to consider how God might be calling you to participate in and support the ministry of Christ Lutheran Church. You'll hear inspiring stories from fellow congregation members about why they passionately support our ministry here. You'll listen to heartwarming narratives of how the various ministries within these walls profoundly impact our community. Most importantly, you'll be invited to stand beside us in this vital work by completing an estimate of giving card. Your commitment will help shape our budget and strengthen our partnerships in ministry.

As we embark on this Stewardship Drive, let us remember that it is not just a building but a sacred space where lives are transformed, faith is nurtured, and our community thrives. There are 2 reasons that we ran a deficit. The first being salaries were paid on the 1st of September but the funds were taken out of the account the end of August. The second is we paid for the Steeple renovation in August and we had not collected the amount needed for the bill that was due. Both of these together equaled \$9,777.
